# Syllable Clap, Stomp, or Jump Activity

## **Objective**

Students will practice segmenting words into syllables

## Ages

3-6 years old

### **Materials**

List of 5-10 words to use (1-4 syllable words; depending on age and ability level)

## How to Play

- 1. Say a word aloud (e.g., "picnic") and have the children repeat the word
- 2. Model breaking the word into syllables (e.g., "pic" "nic"). Clap your hands, stomp your feet or jump as your say each syllable
- 3. Then have the students join in clapping, stomping, or jumping as you say the word again, one syllable at a time
- 4. Optional count the number of claps, jumps, or stomps for each word
- 5. Repeat the process for another word

#### Variations and Extensions

- Use the students' names for the words!
- Have the students take turns showing how to break the word into syllables before the rest of the class joins in
- If a student wants to try but is having trouble, you can model that word for them, have them try it with you, and then have them try it on their own
